1. Durga Puja

Introduction

Devi Mahatmya, also known as the Durga Saptasati, is part of the Markandeya Purana and constitutes the chapters 81 through 93.

Durga Puja is commonly done by reciting "Durga Saptashati" which means 700 shlokas referred to Devi Durga. This is a very powerful Puja which helps improve the energy level in the environment and to eliminate all kinds of evil elements.

How it works ?

This is merely NOT a Puranic Story of battle between Devi & Asura. This is a Tantric derivation from Rudrayamala Gouri Tantra, which is conversation between eternal Shiva and his infinite Shakti, Parvati.

This Puja belongs to a totally different genre. Kavacha, Argala, Kilaka and three Rahasya Stotra are the six limbs of this Puja. Hence, they are also recited traditionally along with 700 Shloka of Devi Durga.

While conducting this Puja, Brahmins also have to practise some Mool Mantra and Nyasa before and after this Puja. Also, this Puja requires Shapoddhara and Utkilana mantras, along with two different types of Sukta (Tantrokt & Vedokt).

On a whole, this entire Puja requires a specific prescribed format along with Dhoop, Deep, Shodshopchar Puja and then recitation of Durga Saptasati.

Benefits

The Divine Mother is our own true being, our inherent divinity and wholeness. Her clashes with various demons (Asuras) symbolize our own inward and outward struggles which we face daily. Devi Durga has many forms and each form of Devi Durga helps us balance various spheres of our lives.

2. Lakshmi Puja



Introduction

There are 8 forms of Devi Lakshmi. Each and every form is very essential to make human life more prosperous. Shri Suktam is the most ancient Rigvedic text which helps us get blessings of all 8 forms of Devi Lakshmi.

How it works ?

As this is Rigvedic Hymn, Shri Suktam is recited with a strict adherence to the Chandas (way of singing), to receive the complete blessings of Devi Lakshmi. Generally, 108 recitation of Shri Suktam is mandatory and Guugul Dhoop is offered along with other prescribed materials.

Benefits

“SHRI” means auspiciousness, prosperity, wealth, peace, happiness & fortune. Hence, Shri Suktam is the easiest way to achieve abundance of happiness and auspiciousness in life. By reciting Sri Suktam on the occasion of Lakshmi Puja, the grace of Devi Lakshmi should be obtained easily.

3. Ganesha Puja



Introduction

Lord Ganesha is revered as the God who is the giver of wisdom, wealth, knowledge, fame, honor, rank and all material pleasures. There are numerous Prayers, Mantras & Aarti in our ancient scriptures to appease Lord Ganesha. Out of these, Ganapati Atharvashirsh is the most important, useful & powerful prayer to Lord Ganesha which helps us get their blessings.

How it works ?

Firstly, Shodshopchar Puja is done with Vedic hymns. Necessary materials are offered to Lord Ganesha while conducting this Shodshopchar Puja. Then, Durva – Sindoor and other precious materials / ornaments are offered by reciting Ganapati Atharvashirsh.

Benefits

Recitation of Ganapati Atharvashirsh with Durva & Sindoor grants success & happiness in life. It helps remove all visible & non-visible obstacles in life. It boosts our wisdom and grants us with sharp intellect.

4. Hanuman Puja



Introduction

Lord Hanuman holds many divine powers like Asht Siddhi & Nav Nidhi. As per our Puranic Texts, Lord Hanuman grants boons very easily. There are various ways to worship Lord Hanuman. However, Sunderkand is the most effective & powerful prayer to get the blessing of Lord Janumanjee.

How it works ?

Firstly, Panchopchar Puja of Lord Hanuman should be performed with due rituals. After that, one needs to offer oil, vermilion, and mandar leaves along with Sunderkand which is a 5th chapter of Ramayan.

Benefits

Lord Hanuman holds special significance for those who want to obtain strength, courage, wisdom and knowledge. Plus, this Puja directly heals the effects of Sade Sati and Saturn's adverse transit too. Moreover, this puja protects us from evil & devil forces in life.



5. Vishnu Puja

Introduction

As per our Vedic philosophy, Lord Vishnu is considered as propitious and is worshipped by all sects over the country as he has the power to bring happiness in life and overcome any adverse situation.

How it works ?

Vishnu Puja is done by very famous & powerful stotra, called Vishnu Sahasranaam. This puja begins by traditional shodoshopchar puja in a vedic form. After that, Tulsi leaves, flowers, and rice coated with turmeric is offered by recitation of 11 Vishnu Sahasranaam.

Benefits

Performing Vishnu Puja can easily bring auspiciousness in life in any form. Vishnu Sahasranama grants success & happiness in life. Further, this puja grants success in accomplishment of financial goals.
